



UpToDate with CME available in Epic

As a provider using the Providence Epic electronic health record you have access to the UpToDate tool that will provide CME (Continuing Medical Education) for running clinical searches. UpToDate is a web-based tool that provides physicians with access to evidence-based medical information at the point of care.

As of Jan. 7, 2013, all physicians with a login to the Providence build of Epic will have access to the UpToDate CME version via the Epic toolbar. This version includes CME functionality for all physicians. The first time you use the UpToDate CME version within Epic, you will be prompted to accept a disclaimer. Providers must accept the disclaimer in order to access the CME version of UpToDate. When using this version of UpToDate, you will be able to accrue .5 AMA Category 1 CME credits for every clinical search.

With UpToDate, providers have access to more than 90,000 pages of content, covering all of general medicine and 20 subspecialties. Content is written by a faculty of more than 5,100 authors, editors and peer reviewers, all of whom are practicing physicians and experts in their areas. These physicians review a wide range of source materials, including more than 460 journals, electronic databases (including Medline, The Cochrane Database, Clinical Evidence and ACP Journal Club), the published results from clinical trials, and proceedings from major national meetings. They then synthesize the data and write original topics, which are put through a rigorous three-tier peer review process to ensure accuracy and objectivity. UpToDate accepts no advertising or sponsorships. It is used by more than 450,000 clinicians around the world.

UpToDate CME version is a valuable resource and you are encouraged to take advantage of the program.
